# U.S Citizenship Exam Preparation Classes

Free classes available to lawful permanent U.S. residents to prepare for the citizenship application process, interview and test.

To qualify for the classes, you must be:

- 18 years or older
- a permanent U.S. resident for at least 5 years (3 years if married to a U.S. citizen)
- able to speak, read, write and understand basic English
